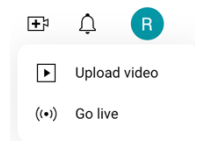

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE VIDEO SUBMISSIONS

The first stage of the audition process, once you have submitted your application form, involves making a video recording of yourself playing your chosen pieces and submitting either via the [Dropbox file request link](#), or via **YouTube** by 5.00pm on Friday 23rd August.

To use YouTube, you will need to:

1. Create your own YouTube channel (if you don't have one already). On your YouTube's home page click on the "create" camera button (top right) and either select "Upload video" or "Go live" to record straight to YouTube.
2. Categorise the video as "unlisted" in the settings (this makes it viewable only by someone who has the link to it).
3. Finally, email the link to your video to: secretary@musiccanterbury.co.nz
4. Your scores, bio and programme notes can still be uploaded to the Dropbox link.



In preparing your submission, please follow the guidelines outlined below:

1. The video must be submitted as one file.
2. Make sure your video and all other filenames include your name.
